MORNING TIME

Post this month's memory verse someplace where everyone can see it. Read it together several times. Now turn away so you can't see the verse anymore and try to repeat the verse together.



MEAL TIME

Ask a kid: How can you point others to Jesus with the way you live your life?

Ask a parent: Whom do you know that lives their life in such a way that it makes people want to know more about Jesus?

BED TIME

Read Acts 9:1-25. Ask God to help you learn to see Jesus for who He really is.
